Parameters (P)

Code	Comment
P1	Your procedure prints instead of returning — a return hands the value back so the caller can use it. Switch to return.
P2	The parameter is declared but never used in the body. Use it, or the procedure isn't actually generalized.

Return (R)

Code	Comment
R1	You return a value but ignore it at the call site. Store or display what comes back.

Abstraction (A)

Code	Comment
A1	You used a library but reimplemented what it already does. Call the library and note the reuse.
A2	Explain the abstraction: how does the parameter let ONE procedure handle MANY cases?

Positive (G)

Code	Comment
G1	Excellent — two calls with different arguments and the return value actually used. That's true procedural abstraction.
G2	Good library choice with a clear reason. Reusing tested code is exactly what the Create PT rewards.
